

Committee Meeting 10<sup>th</sup> August 1846  
The President in the Chair

**Present**

The President introduced the Rev<sup>d</sup> Maurice Cohen who arrived in the “Psyche” on the 9<sup>th</sup> instant, to the Committee. The Rev<sup>d</sup> Gentleman produced testimonials of his abilities as Reader, Shochet and Mohel to the Meeting, stating the arrangements which had been made with him by Samuel Moses Esq. in London.

It was resolved that the Reader receive One Hundred pounds a Year from the Congregation as a fixed Salary with emoluments to the amount of One Hundred pounds at least per annum in addition, and that should such emoluments not amount to the Sum of One Hundred pounds yearly, then the Congregation shall make up the deficiency, so that the Reader shall be in receipt of a total Sum of Two Hundred pounds per Annum.

It was resolved that the President select two Members of the Congregation, Mess<sup>rs</sup> I. Frankel and Philip Levy to assist in making arrangements as to the supply of the Congregation with meat and to choose a Butcher for the purpose.
